



**PROCEEDINGS OF THE SECOND MEETING OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL
(SAC) UNDER THE RTE ACT, 2009 HELD ON 03-12-2015 AT OPEPA**

- The second meeting of the State Advisory Council (SAC) held under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister, School & Mass Education, Govt of Odisha on 3-12-2015 at OPEPA.
- The list of members present in the meeting is attached at 'Annexure-A'.
- The State Project Director, OPEPA welcomed all participants of the SAC.
- The Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Govt, School & Mass Education Department, Odisha briefed all members on the implementation of the RTE Act.

Agenda wise discussion was made as per the following.

Item No.-1

- Proceedings of the first meeting were confirmed by members of the SAC.

Item No.-2

- Action taken report (ATR) of the proceedings of the 1st SAC under the Act, 2009 was circulated to all members.
- Another meeting of the SAC under the RTE Act would be convened shortly after getting views from all members where a detailed discussion will be made on different issues related with the implementation of the RTE Act.

Item No.-3

Progress under the RTE Act was presented by SPD, OPEPA. Following decisions were made.

- SMC should be constituted in all Govt elementary schools/ sections by March, 2016.
- All members of SMC should be trained fully. A diary of monthly activities may be provided to all SMCs.
- Best performing SMC should be awarded.
- Decentralisation of education giving more power to SMCs and Panchayats must be a priority.
- Proper constitution, training and functioning of SMCs must be ensured.

(Action Pont – SPD, OPEPA/ Community Mobilisation)

- Fire safety measures should be taken in all schools.

(Action Pont – SPD, OPEPA/ Civil Work)

- All private unaided schools are required to get NOC from Govt of Odisha. They should apply through the Private School Web Portal. Otherwise they will be given one month notice and closed down as per the RTE norm.

(Action Pont – Director, Elementary Education)

- The process of the rationalisation of teachers at elementary level should be accelerated and the no. of single teacher school should be zero and all schools should maintain PTR as per the RTE norm.

(Action Point – Director, Elementary Education)

- Deployment of elementary school teachers in the offices of DEO, DPC and BEO should be banned.

(Action Point - Director, Elementary Education)

- As per the recommendation of the 1st meeting of the SAC, RTE portal has been created and a part of the OPEPA website i.e. www.opepa.in. However, it should be popularized through different awareness programme and advertisement in electronic and print media.

(Action Point – SPD, OPEPA)

Item no.-4

- Social Audit and School Development Plan (SDP) should be done in all Govt elementary schools as per the RTE Act. Necessary guidelines may be provided to all districts by the end of December, 2015.
- The recent initiative of GoO to elicit suggestions from public for budget making is a good example and may be replicated.
- The Vision 2020 exercise should be revived and may be merged with the Vision 2036 exercise.

- Reforms undertaken by Rajasthan and Delhi regarding No Detention policy and Learning oriented education must be examined carefully.


(Action Pont – SPD, OPEPA)

Item No. – 5

- Data base on children, teacher, infrastructure and other components related with elementary education should be created at the level of Local Authority as per the State RCFCE Rule, 2010.
- A proper public feedback interface on OPEPA Web site for common people to engage with the system may be set up.
