Expression of Interest

1. Back ground:

Odisha School Education Programme Authority (OSEPA), under the School and Mass Education Department, Government of Odisha, already procured & distributed Jaadu Pedi kits comprising fifty-five (55) play-based teaching-learning items (toys, puzzles, flashcards, puppets, manipulative, printed materials, and the kit box) for the Foundational Stage, in alignment with the National Education Policy 2020 and the National Curriculum Framework for Foundational Stage. As per provision, it has been decided for testing of two nos. of randomly selected samples in any NABL Accredited Testing Laboratory of India.

2. Scope of work

The scope of work includes;

- (i) Testing of two nos. of randomly selected Jaadu Pedi Kits samples having 55 items each as per specifications & testing parameters mentioned at Annexure-I. The parameters include testing as per IS 9873, IS 9873 (Part 3) for items so specified, verification of physical and dimensional conformity of items against the approved specifications, including material, dimensions, component count, printing, lamination, and packing parameters, and reporting of deviations, if any.
- (ii) Collection or receipt of samples from O/o State Project Director, OSEPA, Unit-V, Bhubaneswar with proper documentation of sample identity, batch/lot details, and chain of custody.
- (iii) Submission of item-wise test reports of all items on the laboratory letter head having NABL logo, clearly indicating the standard and clauses tested against, test methods, observed values, permissible limits, and a conclusive pass/fail remark.
- (iv) Return of tested sample items to OSEPA which are not damaged during testing.

3. Eligibility Criteria:

The testing laboratory must have;

- (i) Valid NABL Accreditation.
- (ii) NABL Scope of Accreditation for the tests performed as per IS 9873 (Part 3).
- (iii) Valid GST registration.
- (iv) Valid PAN.

4. Documents to be submitted

Interested testing laboratories shall furnish self-attested copy of the following documents ;

- (i) Valid NABL certificate
- (ii) NABL scope of Accreditation for the tests conducted as per IS 9873 (Part 3).
- (iii) Valid GST registration.
- (iv) Valid PAN.
- (v) Filled in copy of Technical format (TECH-1 & TECH-2)
- (vi) Financial Proposal as per FIN-1 format

5. Submission of proposal:

- (i) The proposal in sealed cover with all required documents shall be submitted by

Registered Post / Speed Post /Courier Post only to the specified address on or before the last date and time for submission of proposals as mentioned in Notice Inviting EoI. The OSEPA will not be responsible for postal, courier service delay / any consequence in receiving of the proposal.

- (ii) The OSEPA will not consider any proposal that arrives after the deadline as prescribed in the Notice Inviting EoI. Any Proposal received after the deadline will be out rightly rejected by the OSEPA.
- (iii) The envelope containing the proposal shall be sealed and super scribed as “**EoI FOR TESTING OF ITEMS OF JAADU PEDI KITS**”.
- (iv) Financial Proposal as per FIN -1 format shall be submitted in a separate envelope inside the main envelope.

6. Opening of the proposal:

Proposals received within the due date & time will be opened on the date mentioned in the Notice Inviting EoI in presence of the Agency’s representatives who may wish to attend, at the O/o State Project Director, OSEPA, Unit-V, Bhubaneswar-751001 . Only one representative with a proper authorization letter from the participating agency will be allowed to attend the opening meeting.

7. Evaluation of Proposal & Selection of agency:

A two-stage evaluation process will be conducted as explained below for evaluation of the proposals.

- (i) **1st Stage :** In 1st stage, the proposals will be evaluated to determine whether it complies with the prescribed eligibility condition and the requisite documents / information have been properly furnished by the agency or not. The agency submitted all requisite documents / information shall be considered for 2nd stage of evaluation.
- (ii) **2nd stage:** Financial bid of Agencies qualified in 1st Stage of evaluation shall be opened. The contract will be awarded to the Bidder substantially responsive to the Bid & who has offered the lowest evaluated cost.

8. Performance Security:

The selected Agency will have to submit performance security deposit of **5% of the contract value** in the shape of Demand Draft / Bank Guarantee (BG) drawn on any scheduled commercial bank in favour of State Project Director, OSEPA along with the agreement as its commitment to perform the assignments given under the contract. In case of Bank Guarantee, it should be in the format as given in **Annexure-II** of this EOI & its valid period shall be **3 months** from the date of issue of work order.

OSEPA reserves the right to forfeit the “Performance Security” partly or fully for failure to fulfil the terms and conditions and in case of any obligation. The Performance Security shall be released after three months of expiry of the contract period, provided that there is no breach of contract on the part of the selected agency. No interest shall be paid on the Performance Security at the time of release.

9. Deliverables and Timelines

10. Payment Terms

Payment shall be made within 30 days of submission of complete test reports and invoice, subject to deduction of taxes as applicable. No advance payment shall be admissible.

11. Confidentiality and Ownership

All test reports, data, and records generated under this assignment shall be the property of OSEPA and shall not be shared with any third party without the prior written approval of the Authority.

12. Retesting necessitated on account of laboratory error shall be carried out at no additional cost to the Authority.

13. Language of Proposals:

The proposal and all related correspondence exchanged between the Agency and the Client shall be written in the **English** language. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the proposal may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in English with self- certification for accuracy, in which case, for the purposes of interpretation of the Proposal, the translated version shall govern.

14. Validity of the Proposal:

Proposals shall remain valid for a period of **180 (One Hundred Eighty Days)** from the date of opening of the proposal. OSEPA reserves the right to reject a proposal valid for a shorter period as non-responsive and will make the best efforts to finalize the selection process and award of the contract within the EoI validity period. The EoI validity period may be extended on mutual consent.

15. Amendment of the EoI Document:

At any time before submission of proposals, the OSEPA may amend the EoI by issuing an addendum through OSEPA website. Any such addendum will be binding on all the Agency's. To give Agency's reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their proposals, the OSEPA may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of the proposals.

16. Conflict of Interest:

Conflict of interest exists in the event of:

- (i) Conflicting assignments, typically monitoring and evaluation/ environmental assessment of the same project by the eligible Agency;
- (ii) Consultants, agencies or institutions (individuals or organizations) who have a business or family relation with the OSEPA directly or indirectly; and
- (iii) Practices prohibited under the anti-corruption policy of the Government of India and Government of Odisha. The Agency are to be careful so as not to give rise to a situation where there will be any conflict of interest with the OSEPA as this would amount to their disqualification and breach of contract.

17. Disclosure:

- (i) Agency's have an obligation to disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification of the Agency or termination of its contract.
- (ii) Agency's must disclose if they are or have been the subject of any proceedings (such as blacklisting) or other arrangements relating to bankruptcy, insolvency or the financial standing of the Agency, including but not limited to appointment of any officer such as a receiver in relation to the Agency's personal or business matters or an arrangement with creditors, or of any other similar proceedings.
- (iii) Agency's must disclose if they have been convicted of, or are the subject of any proceedings relating to:
 - a criminal offence or other serious offence punishable under the law of the land, or where they have been found by any regulator or professional body to have committed professional misconduct;
 - corruption including the offer or receipt of an inducement of any kind in relation to obtaining any contract;
 - failure to fulfill any obligations in any jurisdiction relating to the payment of taxes or social security contributions.

18. Anti-corruption Measure:

- A. Any effort by Agency (s) to influence the Client in the evaluation and ranking of financial proposals, and recommendation for award of contract, will result in the rejection of the proposal.
- B. A recommendation for award of Contract shall be rejected if it is determined that the recommended Agency has directly, or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question. In such cases, the Client shall blacklist the Agency either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, disqualifying it from participating in any related bidding process for the said period.

19. Cost of bidding:

The Agency shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its proposal. The Client shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or

outcome of the bidding process. Agency(s) is/ are not allowed to submit more than one proposal under the selection process. Alternate bids are also not allowed.

20. Legal Jurisdiction:

All disputes relating to the contract is subject to the pecuniary jurisdiction of the civil Court at Bhubaneswar and within the territorial jurisdiction of Hon'ble High Court of Orissa.

21. Confidentiality:

Information relating to evaluation of proposals and recommendations concerning awards shall not be disclosed to the Agency's who submitted the proposals or to other persons not officially concerned with the process, until the publication of the award of contract. The undue use by any Consultant of confidential information related to the process may result in rejection of its proposal and may be subject to the provisions of the Client's anti-fraud and corruption policy. During the execution of the assignment except with prior written consent of the Client, the consultant or its personnel shall not at any time communicate to any person or entity any confidential information acquired in the course of the contract.

22. OSEPA's right to accept any proposal, and to reject any or all proposal(s)

The OSEPA reserves the right to accept or reject any proposal, and to annul or amend the bidding/ selection/ evaluation process and reject all proposals at any time prior to award of contract award, without assigning any reason there of and thereby incurring any liability to the Agency's.

23. Copyright, Patents and Other Proprietary Rights:

OSEPA shall be entitled to all intellectual property and other proprietary rights including but not limited to patents, copyrights and trademarks, with regard to documents and other materials which bear a direct relation to or are prepared or collected in consequence or in the course of the execution of this contract. At the OSEPA,s request, the bidder shall take all necessary steps to submit them to the OSEPA in compliance with the requirements of the contract.

24. Force Majeure:

For the purpose of this clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the agency and not involving the agency's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, act of God, operation of law but are not restricted, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, riots, civil commotion, earthquake, epidemics or other natural disasters and restriction imposed by the Government or other bodies, which are beyond the control of the agency, which prevents or delays the execution of the order by the agency If a force Majeure situation arises, the agency shall promptly notify OSEPA in writing of such condition, the cause thereof and the change that is necessitated due to the condition. Until and unless otherwise directed by the OSEPA in writing, the Agency shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as is reasonably practical and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. agency shall advise OSEPA in writing of the beginning and the end of the above causes of delay, within seven days of the occurrence and cessation of the Force Majeure condition. In the event of a delay lasting for more than one

month, if arising out of causes of Force Majeure, OSEPA reserves the right to cancel the contract without any obligation to compensate the agency in any manner for whatsoever reason.

25. Settlement of Disputes:

Any Dispute between the OSEPA and the selected agency shall be made every effort to resolve amicably, by direct informal negotiation. Any disagreement or dispute if still persists/ arising between them (parties) under or arising from or in connection with this Contract then within thirty (30) days from the commencement of such informal negotiation, such dispute resolution proceedings may be initiated on the movement of any PARTY before the Secretary S&ME Deptt. Govt. of Odisha, Bhubaneswar through mediation to resolve which will be final. and the language of such proceedings and that of all documents and communications between the parties in this regard shall be in English.

26. Disqualification of Proposal:

The proposal is liable to be disqualified in the following cases as listed below:

- a. Proposal submitted without EoI Processing fees.
- b. Proposal not submitted in accordance with the procedure and formats as prescribed in the EoI.
- c. Proposal is received in incomplete form.
- d. Proposal is received after due date and time for submission of EoI.
- e. Proposal is not accompanied by all the requisite documents / information.
- f. Proposal submitted with assumptions or conditions.
- g. Proposal is not properly sealed or signed.
- h. Proposal is not conforming to the requirement of the scope of the work of the assignment.
- i. Agency tries to influence the proposal evaluation process by unlawful/corrupt/fraudulent means at any point of time during the EoI process.
- j. Agency's or any person acting on its behalf indulges in corrupt and fraudulent practices. Any other condition / situation which holds the paramount interest of the OSEPA during the overall section process.

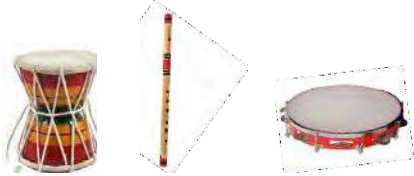

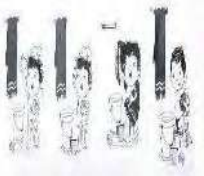

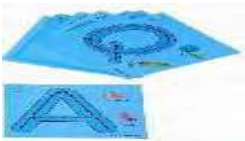
