SCOPE OF WORK AND GENERAL INSTRUCTION FOR BIDDERS

1. The District Project Office Samagra Shiksha ,Kalahandi requires the services of reputed, well established and financially sound Manpower Service Providers to provide services of Date Entry Operators(DEOs) on contract basis for day to day official work.
2. The contract of providing the aforesaid manpower is likely to commence from 01.08.2025 and would continue till 31.07.2026. The period of the contract may be further extended beyond 31.07.2026 provided that the requirement of the Department for 31.07.2026 owing to deficiency in service or substandard quality of manpower deployed by the selected Service Provider OR because of change in the Department's requirements. The Department however, reserves the right to terminate this initial contract at any time after giving 15 days notice to the selected Service Provider.
3. District Project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi has tentative requirement of 13 (Thirteen) nos. of Data Entry Operator. The total requirement may increase / decrease.
4. The estimated cost of the contract is around Rs.30, 00, 000/- (Rupees thirty lakh) only per year.
5. The interested Manpower Service Providers may submit the tender document complete in all respects along with EMD of Rs. 60, 000/- and other requisite documents on or before 11.07.2025 up to 1:00 PM addressed to District Project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi by **registered Post / Speed Post only**. SS, Kalahandi is not responsible for any postal delay. The various crucial dates and information relating to "**Tender for Providing Manpower Services to SS, Kalahandi**" are indicated in the important Information to the Bidder as stated in page-03.
6. The tender has been invited under two bid system i.e. Technical Bid and Financial Bid. The interested Agencies are advised to submit two separate sealed envelopes superscribing "**Tender for Providing Manpower Services to SS, Kalahandi**" & "**Financial Bid for Providing Manpower Services**" to SS, Kalahandi. Both sealed envelopes should be kept in another sealed envelope super scribing "**Tender for Providing Manpower Services to SS, Kalahandi**". The tender should be addressed to District Project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi".

7. **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)** of Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand)only refundable (without interest) may be submitted in form of Demand Draft of any Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of District Project Coordinator,SS,Kalahandi, **failing which the tender shall be rejected summarily.**
8. The successful Tenderer will have to deposit a Performance security deposit of 5% of the contract value only in form of Bank guarantee/Bank draft drawn in favour District Project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi. In case, the contract is further extended beyond the initial period the Bank guarantee will have to be accordingly renewed by the successfully tenderers. In case of renewal, the amount of performance security deposit is to be determined by the DPO, SS, Kalahandi taking in to account the contractual obligation of the manpower service provider.
9. The tendering Manpower Service providers are required to enclose self attested photocopies of the following documents along with the Technical Bid, **failing which their bids shall be summarily / out rightly rejected and will not be considered any further:**
 - (a) Registration certificate of the applicant's organization.
 - (b) Documentary proof of the registered office or one of the branch offices of the manpower service providers located in Kalahandi (Bhawanipatna)

The Bidders who meets the qualitative requirements specified in the Technical Bid will only be considered for participating in the Financial Bid. Financial Bid of the technically disqualified bidders will not be opened.

10. **The conditional bids shall not be considered and will be out rightly rejected in very first instance.**
11. All entries in the tender form should be legible and filled clearly. If the space for furnishing information is insufficient, a separate sheet duly signed by the authorized signatory may be attached. **No overwriting or cutting is permitted in the Financial Bid form. In such cases, the tender shall be summarily rejected.** However, the cuttings, if any, in the Technical Bid Application must be initiated by the person authorized to sign the tender bids.
12. The Technical bids shall be opened on the scheduled date and time **at 4.00 PM on 11.07.2025** in the conference Hall of SS, Kalahandi in the presence of the representatives of the Manpower Service providers, if any, who wish to be present on the spot at that time.
13. The Financial Bid of only those tenderers will be opened whose Technical bids are found in order. The date, time & place of opening of Financial BID will be communicated after evaluation of Technical BID.
14. The Collector-cum-Chairman, SS, Kalahandi reserves the right to annul all OR any of the bids without assigning any reasons thereof.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TENDER IN MANPOWER SERVICE PROVIDER

1. The tendering manpower service provider should fulfil the following technical specification.
 - a. They should be registered with the appropriate registration authority;
 - b. The registered office or one of the branch offices of the manpower service providers should be located within the jurisdiction of the user Department/Office.
 - c. They should have at least three years experience in providing manpower to State Government/ Central Government Departments/PSU on similar work.
 - d. They should have their own Bank Account.
 - e. They should be registered with Income Tax and filed IT-Return for Assessment Year 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25.
 - f. They should be registered with Service Tax Department and obtained ST-3 Return up to 31/03/2025.
 - g. They should be registered with appropriate authorities under Employees Provident Fund and obtained e-challan up to April, 2025.
 - h. They should be registered with appropriate authorities under Employees State Insurance Acts and obtained return upto March 2025 and e-challan on ESI upto April, 2025.
 - i. They should have obtained valid contract Labour License [R & A I Act, 1970 any other regulatory clearance that may be required for providing manpower.
 - j. They should have minimum annual turnover of 10 lakhs each in the FY 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25.

Notes:

1. The total rates quoted by the tendering agency should be inclusive of all statutory / taxation liabilities in force at the time of entering into the contract.
2. The payment shall be made on conclusion of the calendar month only on the basis of no. of working days for which duty has been performed by each manpower.
3. Tender of the Bidder quoted less remunerations than the remuneration mentioned above will be rejected.
4. As District Office is to deduct T DS (IT) @ 2% of the gross billed amount, the service charges quoted should not be less than 2% of the gross amount. Bid of the Bider quoting less than 2% of the gross amount as service charges will be rejected.
5. EPF,ESI,Service tax is to be calculated as per existing rules.Evaluation Committee of District Project Office is authorized to make corrections in case of wrong calculation made by the bidder in respect of EPF,ESI,Service tax rate while determining the lowest-OI(LI) bidder. In this regard the decision of Collector-cum-Chairman, SS, Kalahandi is final and binding to all the bidder.

TERMS CONDITIONS

GENERAL

1. The Agreement shall commence from 01.08.2025 and shall continue till 31.07.2026 unless it is curtailed or terminated by the authority owing to deficiency of service, sub-standard quality of manpower deployed, breach of contract etc or change in requirements of District Project Office.
2. The Agreement shall automatically expire on 31.07.2026 unless extended further by the mutual consent of the manpower service provider and the authority.
3. The Agreement may be extended, on the same terms and condition or with some additions/deletions/modification, for a further specific period mutually agreed upon by the manpower service provider and the Authority.
4. The manpower service provider shall not be allowed to transfer, assign, pledge or subcontract its rights and liabilities under this agreement to any other agency or organization by whatever name be called without the prior written consent of the Authority.
5. The manpower service provider will be bound by the details furnished by it to the Authority while submitting the tender or at subsequent state. In case any of such documents furnished by it is found to be false at any stage, it would be deemed to be breach of terms of Agreement making it liable for legal action besides termination of the agreement.
6. The authority reserves the right to terminate the agreement during initial period also after giving 15 days notice to the manpower service provider.
7. The person deployed shall be required to report for work at 10.00 AM and may also require to work beyond 5.00 PM for which he/she would not be paid any extra remuneration. In case the person deployed remains absent on a particular day or comes late/leaves early on three occasions, proportionate deduction from the remuneration for one day will be made.
8. The manpower service provider shall nominate a coordinator who shall be responsible for immediate interaction with the authorized officer of District Project Coordinator SS, Kalahandi so that optimal services of the persons deployed could be availed without any disruption.

9. The entire financial liability in respect of manpower service deploy in the District Project Office, SS, Kalahandi shall be that of the manpower service provider and the District office, SS, Kalahandi concerned will in no way be liable. It will be the responsibility of the manpower service provider to pay to the person deployed a sum not less than the minimum rate quoted in the financial bid and adduce such evidences as may be required by the DPO,SS, Kalahandi.
10. The payment of remuneration to the manpower has to be through a/c payee cheque only. No cash payment can be made to them.
11. For all intents and purposes, the manpower service provider shall be "Employer" within the meaning of different Rules and Acts in respects of manpower so deployed. The person deployed by the manpower service provider shall not have any claim whatsoever like employer and employee relationship against the DPO, SS, Kalahandi.
12. The manpower service provider shall be solely responsible for the redressal of grievances or resolution of disputes relating to person deployed. The DPO, SS, Kalahandi shall, in no way be responsible for settlement of such issues whatsoever. In case the Grievance of the deployed person are not attended to by the manpower service provider the deployed person can place their grievance before a joint committee consisting of a representative of the DPC, SS, Kalahandi and authorized representative of the manpower service provider.
13. The DPO, SS, Kalahandi shall not be responsible for any financial loss or any injury to any person deployed by the manpower service provider in the course of their performing the functions/duties, or for payment towards any compensation.
14. The persons deployed by the manpower service provider shall not claim nor shall be entitled to pay, perks and other facilities admissible to regular/confirmed employees during the currency or after expiry of the Agreement.

15. In case of termination of this Agreement in its expiry or otherwise the persons deployed by the manpower service provider shall not be entitled to and shall have no claim for any absorption in regular or other capacity.
16. The person deployed shall not claim any benefit or compensation or regularization of deployment with office under the provision of rules and acts. Undertaking from the person deployed to this effect shall be required to be submitted by the Manpower Service Provider.
17. The manpower service provider must be registered with the concerned Govt. Authorities i.e. Labour Department, Provident Fund Authorities, Employees State Insurance Corporation etc, and a copy of the registration certificate should be submitted. The manpower service provider shall comply with all the legal requirements for obtaining license under contract labour (regulations and abolition) act, 1970 if any at his own part and cost.
18. The manpower service provider shall provide a substitute well in advance if there occurs any probability of the person leaving the job due to his/her own personal reasons. The payment in respect of the overlapping period of the substitute shall be the responsibility of the manpower service provider. The manpower service provider shall be responsible for contributions towards provident fund and employees' state insurance, whatever applicable.
19. The person deployed by the manpower service provider should have good police records and no criminal case should be pending against them.
20. The person deployed should be polite, cordial and efficient while handling the assigned work and their actions should promote good will and enhance the image of the DPO, SS, Kalahandi concerned. The manpower service provider shall be responsible for any act of indiscipline on the part of the person deployed.

LEGAL

21. The person deployed shall, during the course of their work be privy to certain qualified documents and information which they are not supposed to divulge to third parties. In view of this they shall be required to take oath of confidentiality and breach of this condition shall make the manpower service provider as well as the person deployed liable for penal action under the application laws besides, action for breach of contract.
 22. The manpower service provider shall be responsible for compliance of all statutory provisions relating to minimum wages payable to different types of worker in respect of the persons deployed by it in the DPO, SS, Kalahandi. The DPO, SS, Kalahandi shall have no liabilities in this regard.
 23. The manpower service provider shall also be liable for depositing all taxes levies, cess, etc. on account of service rendered by it to the DPO, SS, Kalahandi to the concerned tax collection authorities from time to time, as per the rules and regulations in the matter. Attested Xerox copy of such documents shall be furnished to the DPO, SS, Kalahandi.
 24. The manpower service provider shall maintain all statutory registers under the law and shall produce the same on demand, to the authority of the DPO, SS, Kalahandi or any other authority under law.
 25. The tax deduction at source (T.D.S) shall be done as per the provision as per the income tax act/rule, as amended from the time to time and certificate to this effect shall be provided by the Office concerned.
- *Note: Registration/ License under the Contract Labour (Regulation and abolition) Act, 1970 is applicable to Manpower Service Provider employing more than 20 workmen.**
26. In case the manpower service provider fails to comply with any liability under appropriate law and as result thereof, the DPO, SS, Kalahandi is put to any loss/obligation, monetary or otherwise, the office concerned will be entailed to get itself reimbursed out of the outstanding bills or the performance security deposit of the manpower service provider to the extent to the loss or obligation in monetary terms.

27. The Agreement is liable to terminated because of non-performance, deviation of terms and condition of contract, non-payment of remuneration of employed person and non-payment of statutory dues. The District Project Office, SS, Kalahandi will have no liability towards non-payment of remuneration to the person employed by the manpower service provider and the outstanding statutory dues of the service provider to statutory authorities. If any loss or damage is caused to the DPO, SS, Kalahandi concerned by the person deployed, the same will be recovered from the unpaid bills or adjusted from the Performance Security deposit.

FINANCIAL

28. The technical bid should be accompanied with an earnest money deposit (EMD), refundable without interest, as mentioned in para-07 of the Scope of work and general instructions to the bidders in the form of demand draft drawn in any Nationalized Bank in favour of District Project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi failing which the tender shall be rejected out rightly.
29. The Earnest Money Deposit in respect of the agencies which do not qualify the technical bid (first state)/ Financial bid (second competitive stage) shall be returned to them without any interest. In case of successful tendered if the agency fails to deploy the required manpower against the initial requirement within 30 days from date of place in the order, the EMD shall stand forfeited without giving any further notice.
30. The successful Tenderer will have to deposit a Performance security deposit of 5% of the contract value only in form of Bank Guarantee/Bank Draft drawn in favour of District Project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi. In case, the contract is further extended beyond the initial period the Bank guarantee will have to be accordingly renewed by the successfully tenderers. In case of renewal, the amount of performance security deposit is to be determined by the DPO, SS, Kalahandi taking in to account the contractual obligation of the manpower service provider.

31. In case of breach of any terms and conditions attached to the agreement, the performance security deposit of the manpower service provider shall be liable to be forfeited besides annulment of the agreement.
32. The manpower service provider will be responsible for payment of wages/remuneration/salary to the personnel deployed by them. Each month the Agency shall furnish photocopy of Acquittance Roll exhibiting payment released to each personnel, attendance sheet alongwith the bill (in triplicate). There after it shall be reimbursed by District project Office, SS, Kalahandi after verification.
33. The claim in bills regarding employees state insurance, provident fund, service tax, etc. should be necessarily accompanied with documentary proof pertaining to the concerned bill of the month. A requisite portion of the bill or whole of the bill amount shall be held up till such proof is furnished, at the discretion of the District project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi.
34. The amount of penalty calculated @Rs.100/- per day on account of delay, if any in providing a suitable substitute for the period beyond three working days by manpower service provider shall be deducted from its monthly bills in the succeeding month.
35. The authority reserve the right to withdraw or relax any of the terms and conditions mentioned above so as to overcome the problem encountered at a later stage.
36. In the event of any dispute arising in respect of the clauses of the agreement the same shall be resolved through negotiation. Alternatively the dispute shall be referred to the next higher Authority or controlling officer for his/her decision and the same shall be binding on all parties.
37. All disputes shall be under the jurisdiction of the court at the place where the headquarters of Authority who has executed the agreement, is located i.e. Bhawanipatna.
38. The successful bidder will enter into an agreement with District Project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi for supply of suitable and qualified manpower as per requirement of DPO, SS, Kalahandi on the above terms and condition.

And whereas the "Authority" has finalized the rate as per the terms and conditions of the agreement to the Manpower Service Provider, Now this agreement witnesses as below:-

That in consideration of the payment to be made by the authority to the "Manpower Service Provider", the "Manpower Service Provider" hereby agrees with the "Authority" to provide personnel to be engaged as _____ in the _____ name of the office) in conformity with the provisions of the terms conditions.
3. That the "Authority" hereby further agrees to pay the Manpower Service Provider the contract price at the time and in the manner prescribed in the said terms & conditions.
4. That in the event of any dispute that may arise it shall be settled as per the terms and conditions of the contract.

ANNEXURE

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT

1. The agreement shall commence from **01.08.2025** and shall continue till **31.07.2026** unless it is curtail or terminated by the authority owing to deficiency of service, sub-standard quality of manpower deployed, breach of contract etc or change in requirements.
2. The agreement shall automatically expire on **31.07.2026** unless extended further by the mutual consent of the Manpower Service Provider and the Authority.
3. The agreement may be extended on the same terms and conditions or with some additions/deletions/modifications, for further specific period mutually agreed upon by the Manpower Service Provider and the authority.
4. The Manpower Service Provider shall not be allowed to transfer, assign, pledge or subcontract its right and liabilities under this agreement to any other agency or organization by whatever name be called without the prior written consent of the authority.
5. The Manpower Service Provider will be bound by the details furnished by it to the authority while submitting the tender or at a subsequent stage. In case any of such documents furnished by it is found to be false at any stage, it would be deemed to be breach of terms of agreement making it liable for legal action besides termination of agreement.
6. The authority reserves the right to terminate the agreement during initial period also after giving 15 days notice to the Manpower Service Provider.
7. The persons deployed shall be required to report for work at District Project Office, SS, Kalahandi and may also required to work beyond 5.00 PM for which he/she would not be paid any extra remuneration. In case, the person deployed remains absent on a particular day or comes late / leaves early on three occasions, proportionate deduction from the remuneration for one day will be made.

8. The person deployed may be called on holidays to attend duty and shall not be paid extra remuneration by this office on attending such duty.
9. The manpower service provider shall nominate a coordinator who shall be responsible for immediate interaction with the DPO, so that optimal services of the persons deployed could be availed without any disruption.
10. The entire financial liability in respect of manpower service deployed in the DPO, SS, Kalahandi be that of the manpower service provider and the DPO, SS, Kalahandi will in no way be liable. It will be the responsibility of the manpower service provider to pay to the person deployed a sum not less than the minimum rate quoted in the financial bid and adduce such evidences as may be required by the DPO, SS, Kalahandi.
11. The payment of remuneration to the manpower has to be through bank account only. No cash payment can be made to them.
12. For all intents and purposes, the manpower service provider shall be "Employer" within the meaning of different rules and acts in respects of manpower so deployed. The person deployed by the manpower service shall not have any claim whatsoever like employer and employee relationship against the District Project Office.
13. The manpower service provider shall be solely responsible for the redressal of grievances or resolution of disputes relating to person deployed. The District Project Office shall, in no way be responsible for settlement of such issues whatsoever. In case the Grievance of the deployed person are not attended to by the manpower service provider the deployed person can place their grievance before a joint committee consisting of a representative of the DPO, SS, Kalahandi concerned and authorize representative of the manpower service provider.
14. The District Project Office, SS, Kalahandi shall not be responsible for any financial loss or any injury to any person deployed by the manpower service provider in the course of their performing the functions/duties, or for payment towards any compensation.
15. The persons deployed by the manpower service provider shall not claim nor shall be entitled to pay, perks and other facilities admissible to

regular/confirmed employees during the currency or after expiry of the Agreement.

16. In case of termination of this agreement in its expiry or otherwise the persons deployed by the manpower service provider shall not be entitled to and shall have no claim for any absorption in regular or other capacity.
17. The person deployed shall not claim any benefit or compensation or regularization of deployment with office under the provision of rules and acts. Undertaking from the person deployed to this effect shall be required to be submitted by the manpower service provider.
18. The manpower service provider must be registered with the concerned Govt. Authorities i.e. Labour Commissioner, provident fund authorities, Employees State Insurance Corporation etc. and a copy of the registration certificate should be submitted. The manpower service provider shall comply with all the legal requirements for obtaining license under contract labour (regulations and abolition) act, 1970 if any at his own part of cost.
19. The manpower service provider shall provide a substitute well in advance if there occurs any probability of the person leaving the job due to his/her own personal reasons. The payment in respect of the overlapping period of the substitute shall be the responsibility of the manpower service provider. The manpower service provider shall be responsible for contributions towards Provident Fund and Employees state insurance, whatever applicable.
20. The person deployed by the manpower service provider should have good police records and no criminal case should be pending against them.
21. The person deployed should be polite, cordial and efficient while handling the assigned work and their actions should promote good will and enhance the image of the District Project Coordinator office, SS, Kalahandi. The manpower service provider shall be responsible for any act of indiscipline on the part of the person deployed.
22. The person deployed shall during the course of their work be privy to certain qualified documents and information which they are not supposed to divulge to third parties. In view of this they shall be required to take oath of confidentiality and breach of this condition shall make the manpower service

provider as well as the person deployed liable for penal action under the application laws besides, action for breach of contract.

23. The manpower service provider shall be responsible for compliance of all statutory provisions relating to minimum wages payable to different types of worker in respect of the persons deployed by it in the DPO, SS, Kalahandi shall have no liabilities in this regard.
24. The manpower service provider shall also be liable for depositing all taxes, levies, cess, etc. on account of service rendered by it to the DPO concerned to the concerned tax collection authorities from time to time, as per the rules and regulations in the matter. Attested Xerox copy of such documents shall be furnished to the office concerned.
25. The manpower service provider shall maintain all statutory registers under the law and shall produce the same on demand, to the authority of the DPO, SS, Kalahandi or office concerned or any other authority under law.
26. The tax deduction at source(T.D.S) shall be done as per the provision as per the income tax act/rule, as amended from the time to time and certificate to this effect shall be provided by the office concerned.
27. In case the manpower service provider fails to comply with any liability under appropriate law and as result thereof, the District Project Office or the office concerned is put to any loss/obligation, monetary or otherwise, the DPO, SS, Kalahandi will be entailed to get itself reimbursed out of the outstanding bills or the performance security deposit of the manpower service provider to the extent to the loss or obligation in monetary terms.
28. Agreement is liable to terminated because of non-performance deviation of terms and condition of contract, non-payment of remuneration of employed person and non-payment of statutory dues. The District Project Office, SS, Kalahandi or office concerned will have no liability towards non-payment of remuneration to the person employed by the manpower service provider and the outstanding statutory dues of the service provider to statutory authorities. If any loss or damage is caused to the DPO, SS, Kalahandi or office concerned by the person deployed, the same will be recovered from the unpaid bills or adjusted from the performance security deposit.

29. In case of breach of any terms and conditions attached to the agreement, the performance security deposit of the manpower service provider shall be liable to be forfeited besides annulment of the agreement.
30. The manpower service provider will be responsible for payment of wages/remuneration/salary to the personnel deployed by them. Each month the Agency shall furnish photocopy of Acquittance Roll exhibiting payment released to each personnel, attendance sheet alongwith the bill (in triplicate). There after it shall be reimbursed by DPO, SS, Kalahandi after verification.
31. The claim in bills regarding Employees State Insurance, Provident Fund & Service Tax, etc. should necessarily accompanied with documentary proof pertaining to the concerned bill month. A requisite portion of the bill or whole of the bill amount shall be held up till such proof is furnished, at the discretion of the District Project Coordinator, SS, Kalahandi or office concerned.
32. The amount of penalty calculated @Rs.100/- per day on account of delay, if any in providing a suitable substitute for the period beyond three working days by manpower service provider shall be deducted from its monthly bills in the succeeding month.
33. The authority reserve the right to withdraw or relax any of the terms and conditions mentioned above so as to overcome the problem encountered at a later stage.
34. In the event of any dispute arising in respect of the clauses of the agreement the same shall be resolved through negotiation. Alternatively the dispute shall be refer to the next higher authority for controlling officer for his decision and the same shall be binding on all parties.
35. All disputes shall be under the jurisdiction of the court at the place where the headquarters of the authority, who has executed the agreement, is located.
