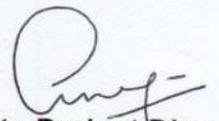

2. Fund Provisions and Release of Payment

2.1 Tri-partite Agreement

There will be Tri-partite agreement between OSEPA/SPO (1st Party), DEO-cum-DPC/DPO(2nd Party) and VTP (3rd Party) for the implementation of the programme. All reimbursements to VTPs shall be made at DPO level and monitoring will be done by both 1st Party and 2nd Party.

2.2 Fund Provisions:

For the services being provided by the selected VTPs, following fund provisions are being made by OSEPA which will be reimbursed to the VTPs by the DEO-cum-DPC/DPO on submission of required reports/documents/bills/vouchers. The amount as worked out is within PAB approval for Vocationalization of School Education programme under centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha /PM SHRI. In case of any revision in the said scheme by PAB, Ministry of Education (MoE)

OSEPA reserves the right to revise these amounts accordingly, if felt necessary. The same revisions, if any, will be final and binding on the selected VTPs.

- (a) **Honorarium of Vocational Trainer (VT) and Vocational Co-ordinator (VC)** : A gross amount of (i) Rs. 2,40,000/- per annum per Vocational Trainer (VT) i.e. @ Rs. 20,000/- per month per VT and (ii) Rs.3,60,000/- per annum per Vocational Coordinator (VC) i.e. @ Rs. 30,000/- per month per VC has been provisioned towards honorarium of VT and VC respectively to be deployed in the selected schools by the 3rd PARTY. The above amount is inclusive of both employee and employer share of EPF, taxes, charges, duties, levies, cess, etc., if any, as per provisions. The remuneration as mentioned above is subject to revision from time to time as per the budget provisions made in AWP&B and approval by State Government/Appropriate Authority.
- (b) **Administrative and other Charges:** 15 % of the amount paid as honorarium to VTs has been provisioned towards administrative and other charges. This includes, cost of (i) recruitment and management of VTs and VCs, (ii) leave reserve and backup VTs in case a VT quits or takes long term leave on any ground (iii) State Head Honorarium and expenses (iv) orientation programme of VC and VTs (v) field visits of Vocational Coordinator (vi) office expenses (vii) awareness, publicity, IEC (viii) guidance (ix) transportation (x) internet charges and communication charges (xi) stationary and (xii) other related administrative, overhead charges, miscellaneous expenses for handling of the Project by the agency etc. The above administrative charges @15% of the VT honorarium on Rs.20,000/- per month shall remain unchanged for the entire contract period. It will not be increased in case of increase of remuneration of the VTs, if any, during the contract period.

2.3 Expenditure to be made by the Selected VTP and Reimbursement thereof

The selected VTP shall incur expenditure in accordance with the provisions / stipulation narrated above from its own fund initially and there after submit the reimbursement claim to concerned DEO-cum-DPC/DPO with all required document /reports / papers. Under no circumstances, advance payment shall be made to the selected VTP. The remuneration of the VTs and VCs pertaining to preceding month shall be released by the VTP on or before 1st week

of next month as per provision positively. The remunerations shall be released by VTP to the bank account of the VT/ VC ONLY through electronic mode. The VTP shall submit bill/invoice with all required documents to DEO-cum-DPC/DPO by 2nd week of next month for reimbursement of VT/VC honorarium already paid by them for preceding month as well as release of payment towards Administrative and other charges. Bill/invoice submitted by the VTP without the documents / reports / papers as detailed above shall not be considered for payment by the DEO-cum-DPC/DPO.

2.4 Details of Expenditure and payment Schedule:

(a) Release of payment by DEO-cum-DPC/DPO to the VTPs.

(b.) Expenditure to be made by the VTPs and Reimbursement there of:

The VTPs shall incur expenditure in accordance with the provisions / stipulation narrated above from its own fund initially and there after submit the reimbursement claim to OSEPA/DPO with all required document /reports / papers as detailed in EOI document. Under no circumstances, advance payment shall be made by OSEPA/DPO to the VTPs. The remuneration of the VTs and VCs pertaining to preceding month shall be released by the VTPs on or before 1st week of next month as per provision positively. The remunerations shall be released by VTP to the bank account of the VT/VC ONLY through electronic mode. VTP shall submit bill/invoice with all required documents to OSEPA/DPO by 2nd week of next month for reimbursement of VT/VC honorarium already paid by them for preceding month as well as release of payment towards Administrative & other charges. Bill/Invoice submitted by the selected VTP without the document / reports / papers as detailed above shall not be considered for payment by DEO-cum-DPC/DPO.

2.5 Penalty clause:

- a. The VTP is required to adhere to the date & time schedule for smooth operation of the programme. In case of delay in initial joining of VT beyond the timeline given by OSEPA/DPO for joining, then a penalty of ₹500/- per calendar day of delay will be charged. In case of delay in hiring / substitution of VTs in hard, special & remote areas, maximum extension for 10 days can be given with due approval of SPD, OSEPA.
- b. **Absence of Vocational trainer for more than 04 working days without intimation or 07 working days with intimation:** Penalty of ₹500/- per day w.e.f day of absence should be imposed on concerned VTP. A copy of the leave application should be sent to DEO-cum-DPC/DPO through principal/HM with respective invoice.
- c. **Vocational coordinators who are not visiting minimum 15 schools during a calendar month:** Penalty of ₹750/- per visit shall be imposed.
- d. Continued absence of VC & VT for more than 07 calendar days: Show cause notice will be issued to the VTP which needs to be replied within 03 days.
- e. However, SPD OSEPA reserved the right to impose / condone the penalty which will be final & binding to all selected VTPs.

4 Submission of Proposal:

The proposal with all required documents shall be submitted by **Registered Post / Speed Post /Courier Post** only to the specified address on or before the last date and time for submission of proposals as mentioned in AGENCY Data Sheet. The OSEPA will not be responsible for postal, courier service delay / any consequence in receiving of the proposal. Each page of the proposal should be numbered and in conformity with eligibility criteria and clearly indicated using an index page. The OSEPA will not consider any proposal that arrives after the deadline as prescribed in the Agency Data Sheet. Any Proposal received after the deadline will be outrightly rejected by the OSEPA.

5 Opening of the proposal:

Proposals received within the due date & time will be opened by the OSEPA in presence of the Agency’s representatives at the location, date specified in the Agency Data Sheet. Only one representative with a proper authorization letter from the participating agency will be allowed to attend the opening meeting.

6 Evaluation of Proposal & Selection of agency:

Three stage evaluation process will be conducted as explained below for evaluation of the proposals.

- (a) **1st Stage** :In 1st stage, the proposals will be evaluated to determine whether it complies with the prescribed eligibility condition and the requisite documents / information have been properly

furnished by the agency or not. A sector wise list of applicants who fulfills the minimum eligible criteria shall be prepared and to be called as **LIST-1**. In 1st stage of evaluation, submission of following documents / information will be verified :

- Filled in EOI Submission Check List in Original (**Annexure-I**)
- Covering letter (**TECH-1**) on Agency's letterhead requesting to participate in the selection process.
- Bid Processing Fee of ₹ 5,000/-
- Self-attested copy of the documents/ papers as asked for in **Table-1 & Table-2** of the eligibility criteria.
- General Details of the Agency (**TECH-2**).
- Financial Details of the Agency (**TECH-3**) & (**TECH-4**) along with all the supportive documents as applicable duly signed as per the instruction.
- Duly filled in other formats **TECH-5, TECH-6, TECH-7 and TECH-8**.
- Duly filled in **TECH-9** in case of existing VTPs associated with OSEPA for Vocational Education programme.
- Power of Attorney (**TECH-10**) in favor of the person signing the EoI on behalf of the Agency.
- Supporting documents as asked for against Technical Parameters mentioned in Technical Evaluation (2nd Stage).

*** Bids not complying with any of the above requirement will be out rightly rejected at the discretion of the OSEPA's authority.**

(b) 2nd Stage :

- (i) The agencies qualified in the 1st Stage of Evaluation (**LIST-1**) shall only be considered for 2nd Stage of Evaluation. In 2nd Stage, following parameters will be adopted for evaluation of the proposals.

(ii) On the basis of documents submitted by the Agencies, marks will be awarded on technical parameters as mentioned above. Thereafter, a sector wise list of agencies secured minimum 45 marks and more out of 70 marks will be prepared & shortlisted in order of merit. This shall be called as provisional

LIST-2. However, OSEPA may add/less the nos. of applicants in LIST-2 irrespective of marks secured by them depending on the requirement and sector wise nos. of application received from different agencies. Decision of OSEPA in this regard is final & binding to all agencies. Final LIST -2 will be prepared by OSEPA after considering the requirement & sector wise application so received.

(c) 3rd stage:

- (i) The applicants in final LIST-2 shall be invited to make a detailed presentation before the OSEPA Evaluation Committee on **virtual mode**. The link for the purpose will be provided by OSEPA to the **final LIST-2 applicants**. The Committee shall award marks, as per the criteria given in the table below:

- (d) The total marks secured by the **final LIST-2 applicants** out of a **maximum of 100 marks (70 marks + 30 marks)** as mentioned above in this section will be calculated & a list will be prepared. This list shall be called as **LIST-3**. The agencies in **LIST-3** are to be ranked on the basis of total marks secured by them out of **100 marks** in a descending order. Accordingly, as per requirement, work order will be issued to the agencies found place in **LIST-3** in order of merit. The number of VTPs to be selected for issuance of work order & award of contract for the implementation of the programme is the sole discretion of OSEPA. The selected VTPs will have to execute an agreement within 15 days of issue of work order.
- (e) The agencies which are in **LIST 3** but not given any assignment, are to be kept in a panel list sector/trade wise. OSEPA may consider giving assignment from the above panel in case of any future requirement. These future requirements may arises due to accordance of approval of additional schools by Government, surrender of the assignment already given to the VTPs, cancellation of

contract with the existing VTPs etc. However, decision of OSEPA is final & binding to all the Agency in this regard.

- (f) Empanelment will not guarantee issue of work order.

7 EOI Processing Fees:

The Agency must furnish the required EoI processing fee amounting to Rs.5,000/- (Five Thousand Rupees Only) (non-refundable) in shape of DD / BC from any scheduled commercial bank in favor of “State project Director, OSEPA” payable at Bhubaneswar. Proposals received without EoI processing fee will be out rightly rejected.

8 Performance Security:

The selected Vocational Training Partner (VTP) will have to submit performance security deposit of 5% of the contract value in shape of Demand Draft / Bank Guarantee (BG) drawn on any scheduled commercial bank in favor of State Project Director, OSEPA along with the agreement as its commitment to perform the assignments given under the contract. In case of Bank Guarantee, it should be in the format as given in **Annexure-II** of this EOI& its valid period shall be **thirty months** from the date of issue of work order.

OSEPA reserves the right to forfeit the “Performance Security” partly or fully for failure to fulfil the terms and conditions and obligation as mentioned in this Agreement by the 3rd PARTY. The Performance Security shall be released after three months of expiry of contract period provided that there is no breach of contract on the part of the 3rd PARTY. No interest shall be paid on the Performance security at the time of release.

9 Language of Proposals:

The proposal and all related correspondence exchanged between the AGENCY and the Client shall be written in the **English** language. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the proposal may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in English with self- certification for accuracy, in which case, for the purposes of interpretation of the Proposal, the translated version shall govern.

10 Validity of the Proposal:

Proposals shall remain valid for a period of **180 (One Hundred Eighty Days)** from the date of opening of the proposal. The OSEPA reserves the right to reject a proposal valid for a shorter period as non-responsive and will make the best efforts to finalize the selection process and award of the contract within the EOI validity period. The EOI validity period may be extended on mutual consent.

11 Amendment of the EOI Document:

At any time before submission of proposals, the Client may amend the EOI by issuing an addendum through OSEPA website. Any such addendum will be binding on all the AGENCYs. To give AGENCYs reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their proposals, the Client may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of the proposals.

12 Conflict of Interest:

Conflict of interest exists in the event of:

- (i) Conflicting assignments, typically monitoring and evaluation/ environmental assessment of the same project by the eligible AGENCY;
- (ii) Consultants, agencies or institutions (individuals or organizations) who have a business or family relation with the Client directly or indirectly; and
- (iii) Practices prohibited under the anti-corruption policy of the Government of India and Government of Odisha. The AGENCYs are to be careful so as not to give rise to a situation where there will be any conflict of interest with the Client as this would amount to their disqualification and breach of contract.

13 Disclosure:

- a.) AGENCYs have an obligation to disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification of the AGENCY or termination of its contract.
- b.) AGENCYs must disclose if they are or have been the subject of any proceedings (such as blacklisting) or other arrangements relating to bankruptcy, insolvency or the financial standing of the AGENCY, including but not limited to appointment of any officer such as a receiver in relation to the AGENCY's personal or business matters or an arrangement with creditors, or of any other similar proceedings.
- c.) AGENCYs must disclose if they have been convicted of, or are the subject of any proceedings relating to:
 - a criminal offence or other serious offence punishable under the law of the land, or where they have been found by any regulator or professional body to have committed professional misconduct;
 - corruption including the offer or receipt of an inducement of any kind in relation to obtaining any contract;
 - failure to fulfill any obligations in any jurisdiction relating to the payment of taxes or social security contributions.

14 Anti-corruption Measure:

- a. Any effort by AGENCY(s) to influence the Client in the evaluation and ranking of financial proposals, and recommendation for award of contract, will result in the rejection of the proposal.
- b. A recommendation for award of Contract shall be rejected if it is determined that the recommended AGENCY has directly, or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question. In such cases, the Client shall blacklist the AGENCY either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, disqualifying it from participating in any related bidding process for the said period.

15 Cost of bidding:

The AGENCY shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its proposal. The Client shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the

bidding process. AGENCY(s) is/ are not allowed to submit more than one proposal under the selection process. Alternate bids are also not allowed.

16 Legal Jurisdiction:

All disputes relating to the contract is subject to the pecuniary jurisdiction of the civil Court at Bhubaneswar and within the territorial jurisdiction of Hon'ble High Court of Orissa.

17 Confidentiality:

Information relating to evaluation of proposals and recommendations concerning awards shall not be disclosed to the AGENCYs who submitted the proposals or to other persons not officially concerned with the process, until the publication of the award of contract. The undue use by any Consultant of confidential information related to the process may result in rejection of its proposal and may be subject to the provisions of the Client's anti-fraud and corruption policy. During the execution of the assignment except with prior written consent of the Client, the consultant or its personnel shall not at any time communicate to any person or entity any confidential information acquired in the course of the contract.

18 OSEPA's right to accept any proposal, and to reject any or all proposal(s)

The OSEPA reserves the right to accept or reject any proposal, and to annul or amend the bidding/ selection/ evaluation process and reject all proposals at any time prior to award of contract award, without assigning any reason there of and thereby incurring any liability to the AGENCYs.

19 Copyright, Patents and Other Proprietary Rights:

OSEPA shall be entitled to all intellectual property and other proprietary rights including but not limited to patents, copyrights and trademarks, with regard to documents and other materials which bear a direct relation to or are prepared or collected in consequence or in the course of the execution of this contract. At the OSEPA,s request, the VTP shall take all necessary steps to submit them to the OSEPA in compliance with the requirements of the contract.

20 Force Majeure:

For the purpose of this clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the agency and not involving the agency"s fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, act of God, operation of law but are not restricted, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, riots, civil commotion, earthquake, epidemics or other natural disasters and restriction imposed by the Government or other bodies, which are beyond the control of the agency, which prevents or delays the execution of the order by the agency If a force Majeure situation arises, the VTP shall promptly notify OSEPA in writing of such condition, the cause thereof and the change that is necessitated due to the condition. Until and unless otherwise directed by the OSEPA in writing, the Agency shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. The VTP shall advise OSEPA in writing, the beginning and the end of the above causes of delay, within seven days of the occurrence and cessation of the Force Majeure condition. In the event of a

delay lasting for more than one month, if arising out of causes of Force Majeure, OSEPA reserves the right to cancel the contract without any obligation to compensate the agency in any manner for whatsoever reason.

21 Settlement of Disputes:

Any Dispute arising upto 2nd PARTY level must be resolved at 2nd PARTY level. In case of non-resolve of the same at District level then the 1st PARTY and the 3rd PARTY shall make every effort to resolve amicably, by direct informal negotiation. Any disagreement or dispute if still persists/ arising between them (parties) under or arising from or in connection with this Contract then within thirty (30) days from the commencement of such informal negotiation, such dispute resolution proceedings may be initiated on the movement of any PARTY before the Secretary S&ME Deptt. Govt. of Odisha, Bhubaneswar through mediation to resolve which will be final. and the language of such proceedings and that of all documents and communications between the parties in this regards shall be in English.

22 Disqualification of Proposal:

The proposal is liable to be disqualified in the following cases as listed below:

- a) Proposal submitted without EOI Processing fees.
- b) Proposal not submitted in accordance with the procedure and formats as prescribed in the EOI.
- c) Proposal is received in incomplete form.
- d) Proposal is received after due date and time for submission of EOI.
- e) Proposal is not accompanied by all the requisite documents / information.
- f) Proposal submitted with assumptions or conditions.
- g) Proposal is not properly sealed or signed.
- h) Proposal is not conforming to the requirement of the scope of the work of the assignment.
- i) Agency tries to influence the proposal evaluation process by unlawful/corrupt/fraudulent means at any point of time during the EOI process.
- j) Agency's or any person acting on its behalf indulges in corrupt and fraudulent practices. Any other condition / situation which holds the paramount interest of the OSEPA during the overall section process.

23 Exclusion of Blacklisted/Terminated Entities

VTPs previously blacklisted/terminated or surrendered schools in respect of projects implemented by OSEPA shall not be considered for selection. Similarly, the VCs and VTs who are terminated by the VTPs in the previous assignment given by OSEPA shall not be considered for recruitment by VTPs.

24 Self-Certified Declaration Requirement

The existing VTPs associated with OSEPA for Vocational Education programme shall furnish a self-certified declaration in TECH-9 format on "payment of all remuneration of VTs & VCs has been made to

up-to the previous month of EOI publication” along with the Application or else their application shall not be considered and liable for rejection.

25 Merger/Closure of VTP

In case of merger / closure of the selected VTP organization, the concerned VTP shall inform OSEPA minimum two months before occurrence of such event and surrender all the projects. In such case , the concerned VTP shall clear all liability in connection with remuneration of VT,VC& other expenditure as mentioned in the contract. In such cases, OSEPA is at the liberty to distribute the surrendered schools to other empaneled VTPs.

26 Contract period

The contract period for the assignment shall be 02 (two) years from the date of signing the agreement which is depending on approval of PAB and availability of Funds. OSEPA will review the performance of the engaged VTPs in regular interval. Further continuance of work of engaged VTPs depends on the performance review of OSEPA as well as availability of budgetary provision. The contract can be extended further on the basis of mutual consent. However, the decision of OSEPA in this regard is final and binding on the engaged VTP.

28. Maternity Leave and SPL Leave shall be applicable as per the State Govt. provision for outsourcing employee as per Resolution No 7982 Dtd. 07.03.2024 of GA & PG Deptt. and Office Memorandum No 30794 Dtd. 06.11.2021 of Finance Deptt. or any revision made by State Govt. from time to time.

SECTION: 2

TERMS OF REFERENCE(ToR)

I. Scope of Work

The Government of India had brought out a Vocationalization of School Education (VSE) under Samagra Shiksha/PM SHRI by integrating employability education into School Education. The scheme is operated within the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF), earlier called NVEQF, which establishes a system of clear educational pathways from school to higher education while providing certification of vocational skills. Government of India has sanctioned 315 Sector Schools for Odisha.

The project will be implemented at 315 (Sector Schools) Government schools in ODISHA with the goal to make students employable when they complete senior secondary education. The schools have already been identified and approved till AWP&B 2025-26. The Project will adopt new curriculum, course content and pedagogy, hire and train qualified vocational teachers, introduce the program in schools, monitor and evaluate its progress, etc.as per the guidelines and norms of Ministry of Education (MoE),GOI. The curriculum, teacher handbook, student handbook are already developed by PSSCIVE (PSS Central Institute for Vocational Education, Bhopal), based on the relevant Qualification Packs / National Occupational Standards of respective Sector Skill Council. The EOI is floated on the basis of the approval till PAB 2025-26. Sector wise / job role wise details are attached below. The detailed list of Schools are attached in Annexure-III for reference.

The Vocational Training Partner (VTP) will be responsible for providing the following in the proposed programme covering 315 Sector Schools.

II. Roles and Responsibilities

A. Role and Responsibility of OSEPA (1st PARTY)

- (i) To issue instructions, monitor the entire programme implementation and oversee / sort out the operational issues which are escalated to the 1st PARTY.
- (ii) To take policy related decisions on amendment of the agreement clauses from time to time, if required.
- (iii) To make budget provisions on the basis of proposals submitted by the 2nd PARTY and get it approved by Government.
- (iv) To provide funds / fixation of drawl limit against the 2nd PARTY for release of payment to the 3rd PARTY as per provisions.
- (v) To provide delegation of Financial Powers to the district level functionaries from time to time, if required.
- (vi) To intervene and resolve the dispute / queries escalated by the 2nd PARTY and 3rd PARTY. In such cases, the decision of the 1st PARTY shall be final and binding upon other two parties.
- (vii) To organise Induction Training and In-service Training of Vocational Trainers, orientation of Vocational Coordinators and Workshop etc in coordination with 2nd PARTY and/or 3rd PARTY.

B. Role and Responsibility of DEO-cum-DPCs (2nd PARTY)

- (i) To monitor the activities as detailed below for ensuring implementation of the Programme,
 - Vocational Trainer Recruitment.
 - Vocational Coordinator Recruitment.
 - Vocational Trainers' Training.
 - Regular Mentoring and supervision.
 - Acknowledge a VTP State Head identified by the 3rd PARTY who would be coordinating with VTP Coordinator, Schools, Vocational Trainers, monitor activities, and liaison with all stake holders and be a Single Point of Contact at State Level.
 - Acknowledge the Vocational Coordinator, identified by the 3rd PARTY who would be coordinating with Vocational Trainers, monitor training, and liaison with all stake holders and be a single point of contact at District Level or State Level or as placed by the 1st PARTY.
 - Any other activities / intervention specified by 1st PARTY from time to time to ensure successful implementation of the project.
 - Regular monitoring of the project by the Principals / Head Masters in school level and officials at District Level.
 - To monitor and plan the Guest Lecture (GL) and Industry Visit (IV) activities in all schools under Vocational Training Programme in the District.

- (ii) Monitoring and supervision: DEO-cum-DPCs will monitor and review the progress of the programme as per the guidelines issued by 1st PARTY and updates made thereafter from the MoE.
- (iii) **MIS:** Generate MIS related to curriculum coverage, Guest Lectures, industry visits and exposure etc.
- (iv) **Single Point of Contact:** The 2nd PARTY will designate a single point of contact (SPOC) between the 1st PARTY and 3rd PARTY who will be an ADEO rank officer.

C. Role and Responsibility of VTP (3rd PARTY)

- (i) To provide qualified Resource Persons including Vocational Trainer (VT), Vocational Coordinator (VC), State Head etc. as per requirement of the Project.
- (ii) To place the services of the State Head at State office of VTP in Odisha and shall report to Vocational Section time to time for undertaking all the activities assigned to VTPs for smooth implementation of the programme.
- (iii) Ensure that the role given to the VT & VC are performed as per the ToR mentioned below.
- (iv) Must select — Vocational Coordinators, who would act as a point of contact representing the Agency for the program for coordination, monitoring, training, preparing reports and successful implementation of the programme.
- (v) To depute additional Vocational Trainer in the cases of Leave, resignation of the existing vocational trainer on immediate basis.
- (vi) To ensure that the qualifications of the Vocational Trainer should be as per norms prescribed by PSSCIVE, Bhopal / State, as provided in the EoI document.
- (vii) To understand the Curriculum and Course content prepared by PSSCIVE, Bhopal/State and ensure its delivery through its vocational Trainer within stipulated time and meet the quality parameters.
- (viii) To provide support for Career Counselling and guidance support, Internship, Apprenticeship, Job Fair, Placement drive Support, entrepreneurial incubation support through its existing network and expertise.
- (ix) To maintain the database of the students and the Programme and shall provide the same as and when required by the 1st and 2nd PARTY in prescribed format.
- (x) To submit monthly progress report, quarterly progress report and annual report with quality photograph, video, testimonial and case studies by engaging professionals as per the requirement.
- (xi) To map and provide opportunities to students for exposure visit, competitions, workshops and activities related to vocational education to enhance their quality learning.
- (xii) To work as a knowledge partner and shall render its service to popularize the vocational education at different level as and when required by the 1st and 2nd PARTY.
- (xiii) To provide one Vocational Coordinator (VC) for 30-35 schools as per the guideline issued by the 1st PARTY.
- (xiv) To provide one day training to VCs and VTs related to trade and recent developments in each year.
- (xv) To ensure that the Child Protection & Rights policy is in place in the organization as per State Government norms and also to orient and providing counselling to VC and VT on the

same at the time of hiring thereby enabling a conducive environment for the students. All VC and VT must sign a declaration form at the time of joining to abide by the Child Rights and Protection policy issued by the Government from time to time.

- (xvi) To form an internal sexual harassment Committee to address grievances.
- (xvii) To ensure that in no case any of its staff including VT, VC and State Head shall be engaged in any activities which shall be benefit them financially and impacting the programme.
- (xviii) To complete / perform any academic related task / activity given to the VTs / Resource Persons through the 3rd PARTY which will have to be completed within the given time frame.
- (xix) To coordinate and facilitate for mapping of Resource Persons and Industries and organising Guest Lecture (GL) Session and Industry Visit (IV).
- (xx) To prepare and submit the annual plan for the upcoming academic session by first week of January of every academic year.
- (xxi) Responsible for compliance of all statutory provisions of relevant Act / Rules of Government relating to labour and employment in respect of the persons deployed. Neither the 1stPARTY nor the 2nd PARTY shall have liabilities in this regard.
- (xxii) Liable for depositing all taxes, charges , duties, levies, cess, etc. on account of service rendered by them to the concerned Statutory Authorities within stipulated time, as per the prevailing Rules and Regulations in the matter.
